2014 CALDEIRA SYRAH

COOMBSVILLE, NAPA VALLEY



THE WINE:

100% Syrah from the Coombsville AVA of Napa Valley. This single vineyard wine was born from grapes grown on the Caldwell Estate Vineyard – one of Napa's most legendary properties. Made by winemakers Marbue Marke and Sal Galvan the wine was barrel fermented before being aged in French oak 225 Liter barrels for 18 months.

THE ESTATE:

Caldeira is the French term for a crater formed by the eruption and subsequent collapse of the mouth of a volcano. The Coombsville AVA in Napa Valley owes much of its unique terroir to this geologic event. Caldwell Vineyard, the source of the fruit for this wine, is planted with specific clones that thrive in this area of Napa Valley.

TASTING NOTES:

Color: Ink-like purple.

Aromas. Deep blue and black fruits with classic Syrah spices and coffee notes.

Flavors. Ripe, big and round in texture, the flavors of blue plum and blackberry have hints of vanilla oak and subtle, savory spice.

Food Pairing. Grilled baby back ribs, fresh white sweet corn on the cob and a large bulbous glass!
